Date: Saturday, April 16, 2022, 9:00 am – 2:00 pm

Location: Jones Hall, Fort Lewis College

Entry Fee: \$15 per student/\$20 per non-member student, with extra coaching option for an additional \$10 fee.

**Purpose:** The Young Artist Festival is a non-competitive music festival in Durango, Colorado. It is open to students of all instruments and levels. Each student will perform privately for an evaluator and will receive written comments and a verbal critique.

#### **Student Requirements and Procedures:**

- 1. Students must perform one piece** (memorization optional) - bring original music with measures numbered, plus one copy of the music for the evaluator if the piece is not memorized.
- 2. Students may complete one or more options:**
  - **Theory Test** - indicate level on Evaluation Form. Tests will be administered in the theory room at the festival before or after their assigned performance time.
  - **Technique Evaluation** - indicate specific scales/chords/arps on Evaluation Form. Level indication is not necessary and students may complete just one component (i.e. scales only).
  - **2nd Solo piece** (memorization optional) - indicate title and composer on Evaluation Form.
  - **Art Project** - related to music and labeled with student name and teacher. Submit to teacher by April 14. Teacher is responsible for bringing artwork to the festival by 9 AM, Saturday April 16 and picking it up at 2 PM.
  - **Extra Coaching** - student will receive **10 minutes of additional private coaching** with adjudicator (\$10 fee added)
